

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

ABERDEEN

Aberdeen airport is 7 miles (11kms) from the city centre. Airport facilities include, car hire, bureau de change, ATMs, restaurants, café bars and shops.

Train: The nearest railway station is Dyce, a short taxi ride from the airport. There are regular connections from Dyce to the main line station in Aberdeen for onward connections.

Bus: Bus services operate from the airport to Aberdeen city centre, services are less frequent at weekends than weekdays.

Taxi: Taxis are available from the terminal forecourt.

EDINBURGH

Edinburgh airport is 8 miles (13kms) from the city centre. Airport facilities include car hire, bureau de change, ATMs, tourist information, restaurants, café bars and shops.

Train: Edinburgh's main railway station, Waverley, can be reached by bus or taxi from the airport. Onward connections to Scotland and beyond are available from here. Haymarket station is located near to the city centre and is on the main bus route between the airport and city centre.

Bus: Public bus services stop outside the UK arrivals doors on the terminal forecourt. There are a variety of services.

Airlink 100 to Edinburgh city centre – operate every 10 minutes from 04.45-after midnight. Tickets cost £3 single, £5 return. Approximately 25 minutes to the city centre. www.flybybus.com

Airdirect 747 to Fife – connects the airport with Inverkeithing railway station and Ferrytoll Park and Ride in Fife. Operates every 30 minutes, Monday-Saturday and hourly on Sundays. Journey time is approximately 25 minutes. www.airdirect747.com

Edinburgh Shuttle: 7 seater executive mini buses operate every 15-30 minutes between the airport and pick up and drop off anywhere within the Edinburgh Shuttle's city centre zone. They can be from any home, hotel, business or conference venue. They offer discounts for two or more passengers travelling together. The maximum luggage weight is 25kg per item at no extra charge.

Taxi: Taxis operate from the outside the arrivals hall. There are 3 ranks, one for private vehicle taxis, one for “black cabs” and a third for taxis, which have been pre-booked.

GLASGOW

Glasgow airport is 8 miles (13kms) from the city centre. Airport facilities include car hire, bureau de change, ATMs, tourist information, a wide range of restaurants and shops.

Train: Paisley Gilmour Street station is 1 mile from the airport. It can be reached by taxi or by regular bus services. Connections are available to Glasgow Central station, Ayr and Clyde Coast destinations.

Bus: All public buses depart from the front of the terminal building. 905: Services to/from Glasgow city centre operate every 10 minutes during the day Monday-Saturday and every 15-30 minutes in the evenings and on Sunday.

Buses operate to various locations surrounding Glasgow and beyond including Fort William, Kyle of Lochalsh and Skye (Portree), check the website for more information. www.glasgowairport.com

Taxi: The taxi rank is located at the front of the terminal building. Taxis are available 24 hours a day.

GLASGOW PRESTWICK

Glasgow Prestwick is 32 miles (52kms) from Glasgow city centre. Airport facilities include bureau de change, ATMs, car hire, restaurants and shops.

Train: The railway station is adjacent to the airport. Trains operate every 30 minutes (hourly on Sundays) to Glasgow Central station. Journey time is 44 minutes. Trains operate between approximately 06.00-23.00, Monday-Saturday and 10.00-23.00 Sunday. For the latest timetable go to: www.firstscotrail.co.uk. Passengers travelling through Glasgow Prestwick qualify for free or half price rail travel to anywhere in Scotland. Free travel applies only to the first 6 months of a new route being introduced and has to be booked at a First ScotRail booking office or the airport’s information desk. Free tickets are not available on the train. All passengers travelling to and from Glasgow Prestwick will receive 50% discount on the standard fare. To qualify for the discount passengers need to show their official flight confirmation and photo I.D. to the train conductor when buying their ticket.

Bus: Stagecoach Western operates the bus service between the airport terminal and Glasgow Buchanan Bus Station from 06.30-22.20. For more details visit: www.stagecoachbus.co.uk/western.

A bus service is in operation for scheduled flights not served by public transport. The service to Glasgow Prestwick, X99 (Glasgow)/X100 (Edinburgh), leaves Edinburgh Waverley Bridge at 03.30 and Glasgow Buchanan Street at 04.45 with arrival at Glasgow Prestwick at 05.30. The service also operates from Glasgow Prestwick to Glasgow and Edinburgh departing the terminal at 00.15. Times are subject to change, please check www.gpia.co.uk for the latest information and to book tickets online.

INVERNESS

Inverness airport is 8 miles (13kms) to city centre. Airport facilities include banking facilities, an ATM, car hire, a bar, a restaurant and shops.
